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Open letter to the editor of Archive of Oncology from Cancer Registry of Vojvodina

Dear Editor.

It is great pleasure for all of us, from Cancer Registry of Vojvodina (CRV) that we can present our data for 2010. In Vojvodina, in 2010, 10106 new cancer cases were registered. This number will bee a little bit higher in future with regard to data processing, but not significantly. The leading cancer sites for male were: lung, colorectum and prostate (Table 1). Every forth case was lung cancer. Breast, colorectum and lung were the leading cancer sites for female (Table 2). One quarter of all cancer cases was breast cancer. Male/female ratio was 1.11:1.

For comparison with other countries it must be used age standardization procedure (1, 2). In other issue it will be presented new information from CRV. For more precised data you can contact CRV.
